

This book doesn't focus solely on disabilities, but it does show a child in a wheelchair, a child who (I think, but I'm not certain) is portrayed as autistic, a child with a service animal, etc. It does a wonderful job of being inclusive and showing that children who are different in these ways still enjoy companionship & activities like able-bodied children do.

Before I read this book to my class I lent it to a co- worker . My co - worker came back to to me and positively raved about the book and I understand why I enjoyed this book immensely because it covers a wide spectrum of disabilities. When I read the book on my own before reading it to my class I was delighted that I saw children who were physically disabled, mentally disabled and children of different races and ethnic origins!
