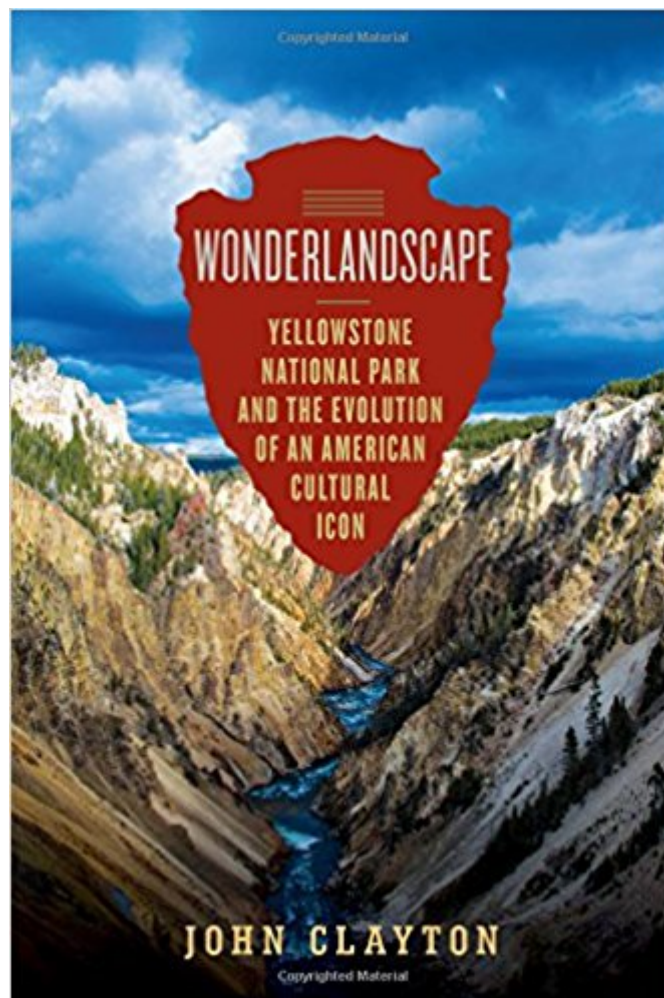




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Wonderlandscape: Yellowstone National Park And The Evolution Of An American Cultural Icon

Subsequent eras added Rooseveltian masculinity, democratic patriotism, ecosystem science, and artistic inspiration as core Yellowstone hallmarks.
