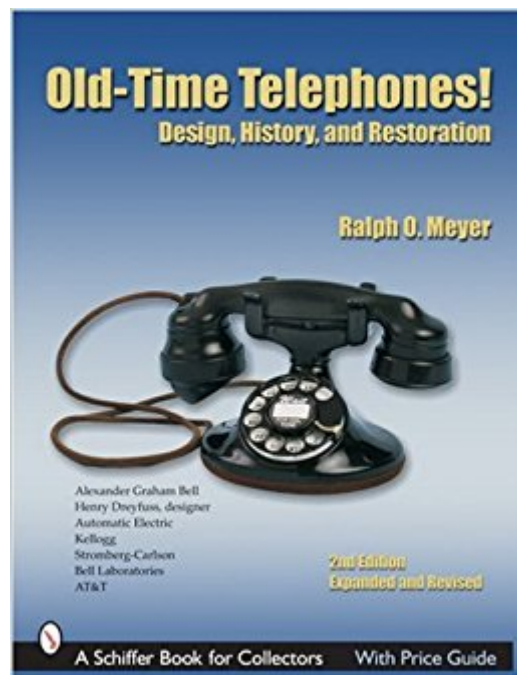

Ralph O. Meyer has been studying, testing, and collecting antique telephones for many years. This is his second book on the subject.

Great! There seem to be only a few books out there on this topic, and this covers a lot of ground. So far I've read the early chapters, which helped me identify which old phone I have (A Western Electric 317 that was in my grandparents farmhouse). Now I'm in the chapters on circuits, which I think will help me to understand how my particular phone needs to be wired (mine has almost no internal parts; someone in the family at one time wanted to make a radio out of it). Later chapters cover restoration. I'll try to remember to return and edit this review when I've read the whole book.

So far I've learned enough to make it worth the price and worth 4 stars. I kind of wish the book had more info on sources of replacement and restoration parts. But, I suppose that may change frequently, and Google is your friend, ya know?

Dr. Ralph Meyer's book, Old-Time Telephones! is scholarly with resources well- documented, yet it is very readable and easily understood by readers with little technical knowledge. The book is full of clear illustrations of phone circuitry and wiring diagrams which makes it a gem for those wanting to work on old phones. The book traces the history of the development of telephones and the major manufacturers of these phones. There are many great pictures of early phones and a section on estimating the value of vintage phones. This is one of the best books I have seen on vintage collectibles. There is not much you could want to know about vintage phones that is not addressed in this book!
