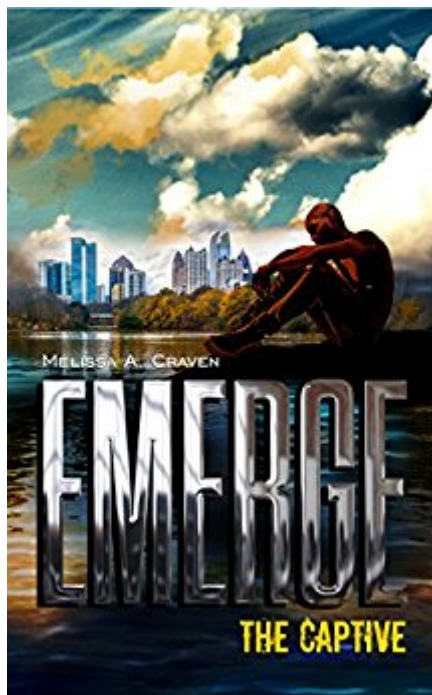


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Emerge: The Captive: (Book 3)

When it seems that you now have a handle on the world of the immortals and surprises seem unlikely, you get once again surprised. This time we get to go with Sasha as she gets trained to be an assassin just as she was foolishly about to risk her own life in order to help Quin escape. We also get to learn what happens to Quin in captivity and the nature of his gifts that so drives his iron self discipline. And we get to know even more characters with gifts that generates awe and surprise in this world of Emerge that seemingly is bent on twisting your mind in new directions every few pages. Hints of the children of prophecy is becoming a more solid fact and I can almost feel the building excitement for a major change in this fascinating world of the immortals. Emerging may not only be applicable to new talents only. Elaborating on this any more will be a real crime. Go grab this book but first caution your house companions to ignore gasping and other silly noises you may make during the reading of it.

At first I was super angry that the book is told in multiple viewpoints, and neither of them were Allies or Aidens. But after the first 3 chapters, I was totally hooked and loved reading this! Ms. Craven has done it again and this one might be my favorite!

Get ready for a rollercoaster ride! This book has so many twists, turns, ups and downs. I think you will find it as breath taking as I did.

I have anxiously waited for this book to come out and it did not disappoint. Usually I don't enjoy books that go back and forth between different person's viewpoints, but I couldn't put this one down. Both Quinn and Sasha's stories were so well developed and answered so many questions. It's an amazing book, definitely my favorite in series so far. Can't wait for what's next.

I think this is the best book in the series so far. There isn't a whole lot of humor, but that's understandable due to the serious nature of the two stories being told. The character development is extremely well done, as is the world-building. I felt the author really took the time that was needed to develop the story. Sasha and Quinn step out of the supportive roles they played in the other books in the series and turn out to be very interesting all on their own. Truth be told, I was afraid this story might be a bit dull since those who have read the first and second books in the series go into the story knowing things that Quinn and Sasha don't. I was wrong. The story held my interest more and more as it progressed. There was one character whose actions were frequently cruel. I sensed there would be a push to humanize that character and build compassion for them. I didn't see how that would work, but it did. I may not have come to like the character, but I did come to feel some empathy for them as less dislike by the end. I appreciate a story that can shift my point of view like that. There's quite a bit of violence in the story and some foul language. No sex or drug use. If it were a film, it would probably be a solid PG-13. Those who have read the second book in the After Trilogy will probably find some similarities with what one of the characters goes through. I do not see that as a negative. I was really impressed with this book. Five stars seems about right. I reviewed an Advance Reader Copy of this book.

This series is so different than any I've ever read and that's one of the things I love about it. The books don't take place in a linear fashion. This book isn't merely the follow up to the one before, but it takes place during the previous book. It follows Sasha and Quinn through their months apart, converging at points with the storylines of our other favorite characters. Quinn has got to be the strongest character in this entire series. He endures months of torture in order to protect his family, protect Sasha. He thinks his power is evil, but it keeps him going when most would give up. Sasha doesn't know where he is and it kills her. Especially when instead of going to rescue him, she's forced to leave for a special kind of training with her sister and a mysterious man with secrets of his own. Sasha and Quinn seem like they're at the beginning of a great love story, but this book tears down everything you thought you knew about them and opens them up for us to see what they're truly made of. Melissa Craven's biggest asset is her ability to develop characters and these are two

of the best.

With a play on words, the book is captivating! The story grabs you right from the start. You feel every emotion, every heart break, every fear, every surge of love that each character feels. The lead hero is complex, confused with his new abilities. He has something to hide and something to fear. The lead heroine is just as complex, fierce, loyal and at the same time questioning who she really loves. The lead villain is complex, fierce, arrogant and REALLY has something to hide. You will be thrown by this one! The secondary characters are not left without complexity either. Together I was left with my heart in my hands and unable to let the book down.

Being told from different viewpoints keeps you on your toes. The character development is excellent. This was a fabulous read which I thoroughly enjoyed. If Ms. Craven remains true to form, the next book will be better yet and I am anxiously waiting for it. I received an ARC and this is my honest review.

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
