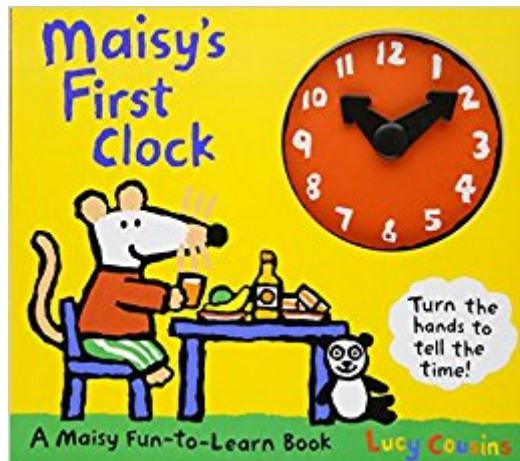

From good morning to good night, Maisy the mouse helps preschoolers learn to tell time. At 8 o'clock, Maisy wakes up and brushes her teeth. At 10 o'clock she grocery shops. Two o'clock finds this perky pink-eared rodent playing in the park. But how does Maisy stick to this rigorous schedule of fun and food? Learning how to tell time is easy with this big, sturdy board book. A die-cut hole through the entire book reveals a colorful pretend clock. Readers move the hands of the clock, which turn gears behind a clear plastic window. A simple printed clock (dots and two "hands") is placed as a hint near the interactive clock, while carefully labeled objects of Maisy's day--"overalls,"

"sandwiches," "rubber duck"--help expand vocabulary. Lucy Cousins's signature style features heavy black lettering on vibrantly hued pages. Kids who fell in love with Maisy in Maisy's Pop-up Playhouse, Maisy's Big Flap Book, and the many other titles by this award-winning artist will love passing time with their favorite bewhiskered pal. Ordered this for three year old, and am looking forward to seeing her (via skype) enjoy such an appealing way to learn. Since her name is Maisie, this adorably illustrated mouse already hold extra appeal for her. She wakes up Mommy in the middle of the night more often now after transition from crib to bed, so we hope understanding the time will help. The book is large and sturdy, and hands on the clock easy for small fingers to move but also stay in place. Each page features activities to which children can relate (and adjust clock to put into context of time).

This book came right away after I ordered it. My 20 month grandson loves it. I hate to think how many times we will read it by the time he reaches kindergarten. He is crazy about clocks.

Our 2.5yo is obsessed with clocks and loves playing with the clock in this book.

Although a board book, the text and subject seem better designed for a 5 to 6 year old than a child requiring a board book. Still, I suppose the "board" is necessary so the clock shows through for each page of text.

My four-year-old loves numbers and likes to tell me the time on digital clocks. He also loves anything that he can manipulate with his hands and he likes Maisy, so this book is great. (The gears that move the hands are visible, so he also gets to see how a clock looks and works on the

inside.)He can change the time and relate it to one of Maisy's daily activities (like eating breakfast, getting dressed, etc.). This is also great as a picture book and promotes early reading skills. I think this is a great book for teaching preschoolers the concept of time.

My 3yo still can't tell time properly, but she gets the concept of there being a time for everything (routine), and at least recognizes "on the hour" times on our clock after this book. Of course, the real challenge is getting her to do what we want her to do at those times!

Good for 3-4 yr. old, not only to tell time, but learn number recognition too.

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
