Streets aren't named and the Piramide Metro stop isn't on the map. I wanted more of Rome. I am using "Walking Rome" and this map was said to go with it, but it doesn't quite do that.

We actually used maps given to us by the bus tour and hotel much more effectively. This map did not help in identifying metro stops and monuments. Monuments on map were not always located on the map facing the correct direction.

This map was fantastic and had transit as well, however it cut off part of the area that we needed (which is still technically part of the city). It would have been nice to have more coverage, however the transit coverage was complete and the map still worked really well.

Can't wait to use it on my trip!

There are lots of free maps available at most hotels. However, none compare to the detail that this map provides. IMO it is worth the expense if you plan on sightseeing on your own without a guide.

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
