

It also, laughably, has suggestions for visiting NYC and for weekend getaways from Long Island, as if there weren't enough pointless lists to fill a book without also including a bunch of better known nearby cities. Because if you're going to Manhattan or Boston, you definitely want to use a guide book about Long Island to get around.
