

Grade 5-10—A sentence-by-sentence, article-by-article interpretation of the Constitution. The first half of the book is arranged to show the original wording of the document in one column, with a translation in simple language on the right. For example, part of Article I Section 9 explaining the Writ of Habeas Corpus, is explained, People who are arrested and put in jail have the right to make the government tell them why they were put in jail. Articles that were later amended or repealed are noted as such. The second half of the book describes how the Constitution has evolved, defines the branches of government, gives details about each amendment, and includes a glossary. This edition updates information about proposed amendments. Boxed fast facts and pen-and-ink drawings and spot art break up the text. No other book in the 320s gives an as easy-to-understand discussion of each sentence as this important document. This excellent and easy to comprehend book is a MUST if you're learning or teaching the constitution. The pages are split down the middle. On the left are the words of the constitution, on the right is a reworded translation for children to easily understand the verbage without changing it's meaning. It is very clear, concise, and NON-INTIMIDATING! After struggling to create an interest in learning the constitution with my 3 homeschooled children ages 9-13, this has been what causes them to proclaim History to be their favorite subject. I recommend this book.

Clearly the "genius" from Oklahoma skipped Dick and Jane (why bother) and went straight to the Complete Works of William Shakespeare in the 1st grade. If there was a political bias, our "genius" clearly didn't pick up on it. For the rest of society, an early introduction to the constitution is a much needed book to get kids interested in government and politics from an early age. The book offers the original constitution and a modern day translation article by article. It raises issues for discussion when the original language is intentionally vague and provides a great teaching and learning tool for the home or the school. This book should be required reading for all middle schools.
