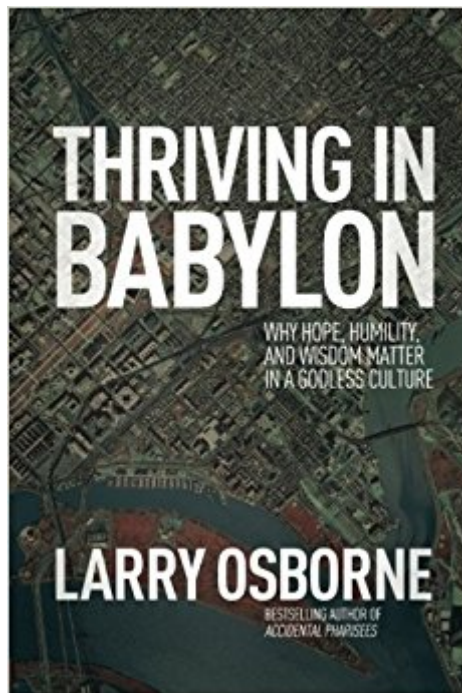




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Thriving In Babylon: Why Hope, Humility, And Wisdom Matter In A Godless Culture
