

Excellent book. Very well researched. For those interested in the history and development of citizenship policies in France and Germany, it is a must read.

This is a great book and Brubaker (along with Benedict Anderson) is one of the leading scholars on identity and identity politics. The scholarship is 5 stars. My problem is with the Kindle edition. It is not formatted properly so it is not clear if a block of text is a paragraph or an inset quote. To put it in short, the margins are literally all over the place. The text spacing is also strange. Words are separated by large tabs of space and other words are strung together as if one long word. This slows down reading considerably. I have tried every size font possible and still cannot get rid of this bug. The last problem is the footnotes. The footnotes/endnotes are not clickable so you have to really search for citation at the end of the book which can cause you to lose our place easily and eats up time. The Kindle version is not worth it. You are much better off simply buying the book and I wish I could get a refund so I could put the money towards buying a hardcopy.
