

I have read this book at least 4 times over the past 4 years. This book was the first fictionalized version of the angel's perspective of "The Fall". Overall, the book is cinematic in its vision and language, which is what attracted to the book in the first place. Wendy Alec has a beautiful imagination and uses that imagination to flesh out a fully developed angelic world. I also like Alec's ability to maintain dual storylines, something that she carries into the next book of the series. Even though, I disagreed with some of her theological points, this was a treasure to read and re-read. I hope to complete the series soon! (I've only read the first 2 books so far!)

In a way it reads like a fantasy but the major details are certainly biblically based. I was a little put off by the characters who seemed to be doing God's work for him but I suspended my disbelief and that was the only negative for me. The character of Lucifer is well drawn and the motivation for his actions are compelling and chilling. I wasn't sure I would like the book but I found myself captured by the narrative and wanting to read the next book in the series.

I'm only a third of the way thru it and I'm struggling to finish it. So very much description about everything...my vocabulary is increasing...I should thank the writer for that, words I'm having to look up as I'm reading the book and not on my kindle. I'm hoping I will finish it. Some of it where you have people working in a lab, I guess because I like to read and study the Bible...some if it is so way off base, even though I do know this is a work of fiction...but it's laughable at times. Maybe I'm just not in the right mode to read it but I'm going to do my best to finish it.

I gave this book five stars because even though it is fiction, to me it was as if so many answers about heaven before the creation of earth were answered. What life for the angels, especially Lucifer's life was like. What life in heaven in general was like. The vivid details and imagery about heaven were lush, the details about how the prototype of mankind :Adam was crafted all the way down to the complex genetic design, it was incredible. How the angels pondered and pondered how to save mankind back in the days of noah because they knew how much God cared for us, yet they

went back and back and checked and double checked and triple checked for a way to save mankind and finally when all hoped was lost they finally found noah, then finding a way to help him through the flood was another challenge in itself, it was great to read from the perspective of the angels executing their plans for noah, in the bible we read from the perspective of noah.I was not sure if I wanted to buy this book or not, I read through the reviews, and finally decided to take a chance, this was my first fiction christian novel. I did not regret my purchase, I ordered book 2,3 and 4 since I liked this one so much. Its seven books in all, only 4 books are in print so far. I am currently reading book 2 The first Judgement, I'll write my review when I finish that one as well.The first 30 or so pages of the book, I did not find so exciting, it was in the future, revelations, a glimpse into the ending of the whole cosmic storyline. Once that was done, the story went back to the beginning of it all which is what I was looking forwards to reading about and it was great, I could not stop reading, once I finished one page I was hungry for the next until I finished the book, and at the ending I was left even more curious thus resulting in me ordering book 2 to continue the story.I recommend this book for all people, if you believe in the bible, dont take this book as gospel but rather as what could have happened with Lucifer and his angelic host. If you dont believe in the bible, its still a great read with a good storyline with interesting characters. Once faithful brothers and then in the end fighting on opposing sides. A tale of a forgotten son, felt abandoned, envy, war, banishment and resentment. Guilt and sadness turned into bitterness and rage finally resulting into overwhelming pride which leads to the cosmic paradigm shift.

Wendy Alec spins a tale that strikes the imagination so deeply you can not stop thinking about it even after the book is finished. So many events are working concurrently that you keep searching to find their common thread. These books are for YA teens to adult. Young children will not be able to process the story line with so many complicated twists and turns, and these are the descriptive actions of adult humans and angles, not children.
