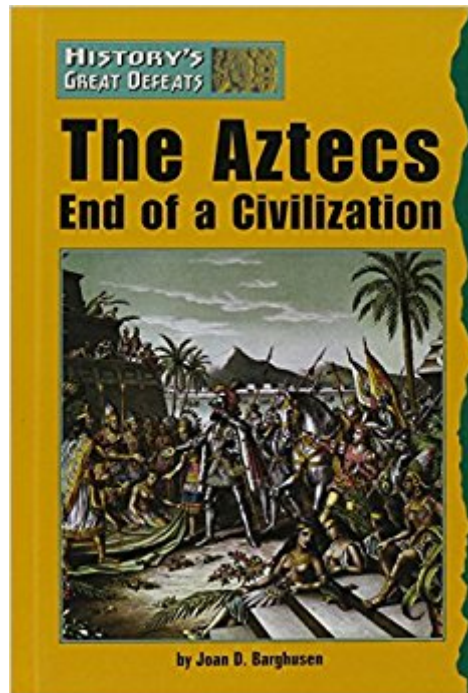




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History's Great Defeats - The Aztecs

Grade 6-10-When Cortés and his small band of Spanish soldiers arrived in Mexico in 1519, the Aztec empire was a great power with a seemingly endless supply of warriors. Despite overwhelming odds, four years later, Cortés ruled. Barghusen's clearly written text explores the weaknesses of this empire and the Spanish conquistadors' advantages in order to explain this unlikely outcome of events. The author relates tales of shifting Aztec allegiances; pockets of resistance and internal strife; and of an invading army that was technologically advanced, more disciplined, and in possession of horses. Using both secondary and primary sources, Barghusen presents convincing arguments. Chapter notes, annotated suggestions for further reading, and a bibliography provide students with other sources of information. Black-and-white reproductions appear throughout.
